After 5 flights, delays and lost luggage, we arrived in the USA on **December 18th**. We are very thankful for our time of language learning in Spain. Check out www.thefarhoudfamily.blogspot.com for a testimony with Sarah's teacher.

WHEN?

When? This is the question everyone is asking us. We want to leave for Equatorial Guinea as soon as possible but we also need to get Judah and Ruth some **immunizations** before going to Equatorial Guinea. We arrived in the USA on Friday December 18th and that Monday we were at the doctor to start the ball rolling and see what's possible. Judah needs shots through April but what surprised us was Ruth needs a booster shot in June.

Would this be possible to get in Africa? Right now there are no missionaries in the country to see what would be possible medically. We have talked to a local pastor in Equatorial Guinea who advised us to do this in the USA. Others suggested going elsewhere in Africa, but right now the borders are sometimes closed due to COVID-19 and it's not easy taking 2 small children across borders.

PRAYER

- Pray for our **language learning** to improve in the coming months
- Pray that we get all the **immunizations** needed
- Pray for all the **details** to be sorted out for us to arrive in Equatorial Guinea as soon as possible.
- Pray that God would speak to others to join our **mission team in EG** and for provision of their finances. (Your prayers are being answered! So far our team includes: David & Roxana Alvarez, Jerad & Amanda Macauley, and Kenzie Bjerken. *Remember there are no AGWM missionaries right now in EG.*)
- Pray for the **church in EG** to grow and help them through the COVID restrictions
- Pray that Sarah's **book Dream Beyond Yourself** would reach those who need its message
- Pray for the **strongholds** to be broken in EG
- **Wisdom** beyond our years

During these months, we will be continuing to improve our Spanish through classes, language partners and attending Spanish church. We know God's timing is perfect and believe this will also allow our team members who are still fundraising to join us near the same time frame. *With COVID many things are uncertain these days, but we feel a peace in our hearts about leaving in June.* **Please keep us in your prayers as we make all the final preparations.**
