




GOD'S WORD BRINGS LIFE

As we gathered together for our first prayer walk at the Soshanguve Campuses, the wind began to blow and the sound of thunder roared in the distance. While discussing some prayer points, a few drops of rain began to fall. The thunder and lightning did not stop us

from beginning our prayer walk on campus. The electricity had also gone out and only a few lights were powered by generators. As I walked through the halls, I took out my cell phone to light my path. God reminded me of the scripture "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path" (Psalm 119:105). I was shocked to see a huge hall filled with light and empty. A generator was being used to power this empty space while students were living in the darkness at their residence. Through this God showed me that our churches are often full of the light of Christ and yet empty. We need to take the light of Jesus to the lost living in the darkness.

As we gathered back together to share what God showed us on the prayer walk, one of the students said Isaiah 55:10,11 was on his heart—which confirmed what God had spoken to me about His Word. God's Word is like the rain from heaven which will bring life to the dry ground of the campus. The storm also reminded us of the spiritual warfare that was going on in the heavenly realms. It is important to remember that the storm will not last forever. Though they are never easy to endure, the storms draw us closer to God which bring us the light and life of Christ.
